

Activate the serial debug on the modem port

To debug a modem problem, it can be usefull to check the AT commands exchanged between the eWON and its internal modem:

Go to the Configuration Menu



Open the System Setup/ General/ diagnosis/ Debug menu




Activate the "Hex and ASCII (no timeout)" on "Debug COM 2" and click the Update button.

- Note -

If you have an eWON with MPI port, then you'll need to select "Debug COM 1"

Go to the Main Menu
