



Special requirements to upgrade firmware 10.# to a higher version

This Knowledge Base explains how to upgrade to the firmware version 10.1s0 or higher if your current firmware is v10.0s0 or v10.0s1.

For technical reasons, we developed, at the same time as the 10.1s0, a minor firmware version: v10.0s2.

On eWON CD and Cosy 141, you might need to first upgrade to 10.0s2 before switching to 10.1s0 or higher.

1. For eWON Flexy & Cosy 131

1.1. Firmware version prior to 10.0s0 (excluded)

In this scenario, you must perform an eWON Recovery.

The solution is to use our <u>Companion tool eBuddy</u>. Be sure to always use the latest version and to perform a backup before launching the recovery process.

1.2. Firmware version is 10.0s0 or 10.0s1

In this case, a simple firmware update is enough.

The best solution to do so is to use our <u>Companion tool eBuddy</u>. Be sure to always use the latest version.

2. For eWON CD & Cosy 141

2.1. Firmware version prior to 10.0s0 (excluded)

A simple firmware update with our <u>Companion tool eBuddy</u> is enough.

To do so, refer to our <u>Support website</u>.

2.2. Firmware version is 10.0s0 or 10.0s1

You first need to install the 10.0s2 before going any further.

Here are few steps to get it done:

Download & install the firmware 10.0s2

On the <u>Manual Firmware Update</u> web page, download the firmware v10.0s2 corresponding to your PCODE (serial number: xxxx-xxxx-YY where YY = PCODE).

Several options are proposed but we recommend to use the **eBuddy** filename compliant

With this method, you need to copy the downloaded file in the eBuddy folder on your computer (by default: C:\Program Files (x86)\eBuddy\Firmware). From there on, simply update the firmware of your eWON.

Install the firmware 10.1s0 or higher

Now that you are using the v10.0s2, you can simply perform an <u>eBuddy upgrade</u> and install the v10.1s0 on your eWON.
