



## Downgrade from 10.1s0 to 10.0s#

### 1. For who?

This Knowledge Base is for users owning an eWON Flexy or Cosy 131.

### 2. For what purpose

If you want to downgrade from a firmware v10.1s0 to a firmware v10.0s#.

### 3. How to?

The switch from a firmware version to an older one inside the same major release can usually be done by simply performing a downgrade by FTP.

Due to the improvements that were brought into the v10.1s0, this cannot be done when the current firmware is v10.1s0 and the older one is one of the service release of v10.0.

In this specific case, the downgrade is not possible and you must turn to an eWON Recovery (just as if you were downgrading to lower major version).
